Today is our Harvest Festival when we collect to give to local charity.



St Mary's will be continuing to support DENS and Emmeline separately publishes a list in the Bulletin.


STEWARDSHIP SECRETARY

Please consider whether you would like to undertake this responsibility. The Job specification is available from Robin or Rosina either of whom might be approached for further information.








LTPT EVENT - RICKY LOPEZ AT THE GATSBY - 25 OCT 2023
