LENT: EPIC FILMS

Following the success of the Lent Epic Film afternoon at St Paul's, the event will be repeated on Monday, 11th March at 1.30pm, when the second choice film about the life of the Christian reformer and abolitionist William Wilberforce will be shown. All welcome.

The film evening Tuesday March 12th at St Mary's - 7pm will give us a chance to watch one of the great stories of faith of Jesus, of the saints, or with a moral to the tale. Those who come along get to decide which title we watch...if necessary we will vote! Then we can have a short discussion afterwards.

LENT: NEW MONASTERY IN ZIMBABWE APPEAL

If you have saved a few pounds by giving up something for Lent you might like to help support the building of Sister Patricia's community's new monastery in The impressive Zimbabwe. project includes accommodation for those who are part of the religious life as well as a church. We look forward to welcoming a refreshed Luke back to us in the summer.
