Church Electoral Roll

The revision of our Electoral Roll (in preparation for the annual meeting - APCM) takes place between 10 April and 23 April. The Parish APCM takes place on 8 May.

The Churches Together Act of Witness on Good Friday (15th April) is going to be rather different this year.

We will not be walking together but meeting at the Market Square in the town centre at 10.45am for a short service which will start at 11.00 am. The theme: 'The Rubbish Cross?' links care for our environment with the Good Friday focus of redemption. Churches are asked to bring bags of clean recycling (no glass or food). We will be filling seven 24 inch cubed metal cages which will be assembled into a cross of rubbish, which, in the service, will be used as the act of repentance and devotion and promise of restoration.

Open church closure!

To facilitate the Extravaganza set up, St Mary's usual church opening will be suspended between Tuesday 26th April and Tuesday 3rd May, church openers will be contacted separately about this.
