Church Electoral Roll

The Churches Together Act of Witness on Good Friday (15th April) is going to be rather different this year.

The theme: 'The Rubbish Cross?' links care for our environment with the Good Friday focus of redemption. Churches are asked to bring bags of clean recycling (no glass or food). We will be filling seven 24 inch cubed metal cages which will be assembled into a cross of rubbish, which, in the service, will be used as the act of repentance and devotion and promise of restoration.


APCM
