# YEAR'S MIND(ANNUAL ANNIVERSARY OF DEATH) DIARIES

An A4 diary will be at the back of each church from this Sunday for you to write (print clearly please!!) the names (first and last) of your departed loved ones in to. These will then be read out as part of the prayers for the departed on the Sunday nearest to the day they died. So ignore the printed year and days in the diary it is only the MONTH and DATE that matters. Find the date of death of your loved one in the diary and write their name in that section, you can write the year of death in brackets after their name if you want but this will not be read out. We will give you a few weeks to complete this and additions can then be made at any time going forward. Speak to Canon John for more details.

## **100-CLUB IMPORTANT NEWS**

It's renewal time! The 100-club year starts in August so we need you to re-subscribe. You've been loyally swelling the church funds and it's even more vital in the coming year with the bills going up so much.

When we started the 100-club in 2013 the subscription was £15 annually, with prizes of £50 a month and the church funds profiting by £900. We all know how inflation has affected our savings and expenditure - the pound has lost 30% of its value in that time, so now we're asking our faithful members for a bigger subscription (which has remained unchanged for 10 years).

£20 instead of the current £15 with an increased prize of £60 a month means the churches will receive £1,280 instead of the current £900.

So please review your annual subscription. If you pay by standing order we're asking you to change it to £20 annually.

To pay by electronic transfer (preferred method) - please use bank sort code 30-80-49, account number 29051660 and ensure you put your name and 100-club number as a reference (e.g. Micky, 68) so that we can identify who's paid. If you'd like to pay by cash or cheque please send £20 to the Parish Office. Cheques for £20 per number should be made payable to the 'St Mary & St Paul PCC'. Please pay up before the first draw in August. Rosina Gaddes will be the St Paul's collector, David Gambling the St Mary's. If you pay another way just let one of us know.
