ANDREW'S 2025 CYCLING IN AID OF DENS

Hello all, it's summer so that means I'm off riding my bike again in aid of our local charity, DENS. This September I'll be attempting their longest ever distance as they've added a 93 mile (150km) route for 2025. Ahead of that I'll be 'warming up' in the mountains of Wales next weekend. I didn't find last year's route as bad as I'd expected, so this year I've signed up for their 134 mile (215km) option.
