The First Sunday of Lent

Today's service is zoomed from St Paul's.

Proposed staged reopening of our churches for Public Worship

The PCC met on Monday to review the current closure of our churches for Public Worship. Being well aware that government and diocesan advice might change and that the current falling of Covid cases might not continue as projected, they agreed the schedule below provisionally and subject to review on March 1st, following the proposed opening of schools.

- 21/2 1st Sunday of Lent: 9.30am Zoom from St Paul's
- 22/2 Government announces roadmap for exiting lockdown
- 28/2 2nd Sunday of Lent: St Mary's 9.30am Zoom
- 7/3 3rd Sunday of Lent: St Paul's 9.30 Zoom
- 8/3 Government plans to reopen schools, details to follow
- 14/3 4th of Lent/Mothering Sunday: Both churches reopen their 9.30 service, zoom also to continue from one each Sunday. Any attending children will have to remain with their families in the pews.
- 21/3 5th Sunday of Lent: 9.30 service at both churches
- 28/3 Palm Sunday: 9.30 services at both churches, 8am Sunday service restarts at St Mary's
- 29/3 Monday of Holy Week: Talk and Compline Zoom
- 30/3 Tuesday of Holy Week: Talk and Compline Zoom. 8am Tuesday service restarts at St Mary's
- 31/3 Wednesday of Holy Week: Talk and Compline Zoom. 10.30am Wednesday service restarts at St Mary's
- 1/4 Maundy Thursday: Usual evening services at both churches, no foot washing and no meal at St Paul's. Vigil to midnight- if possible - in nave at St Mary's.
- 2/4 Good Friday: Usual three hours at St Mary's (and this year on Zoom)
- 3/4 Holy Saturday: no services, no children's workshop/activities
- 4/4 Easter Day: Usual 9.30 Easter services at both churches.
 8am at St Mary's replaces dawn service for this year only and no breakfast will be served.

Standard weekday and Sunday services thereafter.
