HOLY WEEK MEDITATIONS

The Holy Week Meditations on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday will be audio visual meditations by The Rt Revd Christopher Herbert, the former Bishop of St Albans, on three key works of art illustrating the Passion of Christ. There will also be a short time of open discussion and Compline on each evening. The art works included are:

Christ at the Column by Hans Memling (c1485-9), Crucifixion from the Isenheim Altarpiece by Grunewald (c1515), and The Descent from the Cross by Rogier Van Der Weyden (c 1435).

LENT: NEW MONASTERY IN ZIMBABWE APPEAL

ACCESS TO THE TEAM OFFICE

All hall key holders, please note the new arrangement for access to the Team Office. Following a hire arrangement with a Counselling Service access to the outer office (Meeting Room) and inner office (Norma's Office) at St Mary's hall will be restricted.

With immediate effect access to the offices *will not* be possible between:

9.30am - 9pm, Monday to Thursday

12 noon - 9pm Friday,
