Dear St Mary's Church

I am writing on behalf of DENS to thank you for your kind donations given in support of our Foodbank service over the last year April 2022 – March 2023.

You donated 417 kg.

Your donation has enabled us to continue offering emergency food parcels to local people, supporting them through crisis.

The range of services DENS provides helps homeless people make positive changes to their lives, learn new skills and to build their confidence and ultimately assist people to move on into independent living.

Weekly, the Foodbank provides food to the DENS Elms Hostel, which accommodates 44 residents, and to the Day Centre who have provided 2,045 meals throughout the year.

Last year we provided 9,798 people, of which 4,016 were children, with emergency food parcels. This is a 56% increase on the previous year.

Your contribution enables DENS services to provide vital support to those most in need.
